

Co-creation

- Nationwide programme in partnership with the Ministry of Health
- Co-creation of regionally-adapted action plans to prevent violence against health professionals, by:
 - Building the capacity for facilitation of cocreation processes
 - 2. Developing teams' skills for project design and implementation
- Challenge: to adapt the national programme to the local contexts and diversity by running multiple pilot-projects simultaneously

Innovation Culture

- To promote open innovation and an innovation culture (from strategic to operational level, and including evaluation)
 - 1. Capacity building (Open Innovation Day)
 - Experimentation (Experimental Innovation Projects)
 - 3. Recognition (Innovation Incentives and Prizes)
- Challenge: a dynamic and widespread innovation ecosystem, connecting Public Administration, Universities, Businesses and Communities



Looking Ahead: International Cooperation

EU Leadership Exchange Programme



- A project-pilot is being drawn-up collaboratively
- Aim: To allow middle managers from EU central/federal government administrations and from EU institutions to get in touch with international public service best practices and to implement value proposals
- Participants: Middle managers from Portugal, Slovenia, France, Belgium and Spain
- Challenge: project-pilot implementation and evaluation in 1st semester 2022
